- Ensure the Environmental Policy and supporting objectives are understood by all Global Switch staff and contractors; and to provide relevant skills training, induction and awareness training as required.


- Organise activities to reflect best environmental practice, adopt plans and environmental management techniques to pursue sustainability and continual improvement.
